GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for the proper installation, operation and maintenance of the Bryan municipal electric distribution system and related facilities and equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Position requires high school diploma, a minimum of 3 years experience in electric system operation, successful completion of one year of utility Lineworker Training Program, or an equivalent combination of education and experience; possession of a valid Class A Ohio Commercial Driver's License with required endorsements. Ability to successfully complete the next phases of the Power Delivery Program Lineworker Training.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Work on secondary voltage (120/240) unassisted.
2. Have knowledge of and the ability to utilize lineworker safety equipment.
3. Requisition needed tools and material through Lineworker Supervisor.
4. Climb and work off poles up to 40 feet.
5. Assist Lineworkers in most phases of construction and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical facilities.
6. Replenish trucks with stock and keep maintenance check on trucks.
7. Operate line trucks, bucket trucks, trenchers and related electric line building equipment.
8. Maintain records.
9. Perform manual labor and other tasks as instructed.
10. Demonstrate regular and predictable attendance.

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist other utility departments as needed
2. Participate in required training as applicable.
3. Perform other duties as assigned.
