## GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for the proper installation, operation and maintenance of the Bryan municipal electric distribution and transmission system and related facilities and equipment.

## QUALIFICATIONS:

Position requires high school diploma, a minimum of 5 years experience in electric system operation, successful completion of three years of utility Lineworker Training Program, or an equivalent combination of education and experience and possession of a valid Class A Ohio Commercial Driver's License with required endorsements;

## ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Install, operate and maintain all facilities of the electric distribution and transmission system.
2. Proficient knowledge and use of lineworker safety equipment.
3. Requisition needed tools and material through Lineworker Supervisor.
4. Climb and work off poles of heights up to 65 feet.
5. Assist in all phases of construction and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical facilities.
6. Operate line trucks, bucket trucks, trenchers and related electric line building equipment.
7. Work with voltages of 120 volts to 7,200 volts with direct supervision.
8. Work with 138,000 volts with assistance.
9. Replenish trucks with stock and keep maintenance check on trucks.
10. Demonstrate regular and predictable attendance.

## OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist other utility departments as needed
2. Participate in required training as applicable.
3. Perform other duties as assigned.
