GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for the proper installation, operation and maintenance of the Bryan municipal electric distribution and transmission system and related facilities and equipment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Position requires high school diploma, minimum of 7 years experience in electric system operation, successful completion of three years of utility Lineworker Training Program, or an equivalent combination of education and experience; possession of a valid Class A Ohio Commercial Driver's License with required endorsements.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Install, operate and maintain the electric distribution and transmission system.
2. Proficient knowledge and use of lineworker safety equipment.
3. Use gloving techniques on voltages up to 15 kV.
4. Requisition needed tools and materials through Lineworker Supervisor.
5. Climb and work off poles of heights up to 65 feet.
6. Perform all phases of construction and maintenance of overhead and underground electrical facilities.
7. Operate line trucks, bucket trucks, trenchers and related electric line building equipment.
8. Work with voltages of 120 volts to 138,000 volts.
9. Replenish trucks with stock and keep maintenance check on trucks.
10. Maintain records.
11. Connect and disconnect electric hot line equipment.
12. Read substation logs and record power factor readings.
13. Demonstrate regular and predictable attendance.

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assist other utility departments as needed
2. Participate in required training as applicable.
3. Perform other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: (* indicates developed after employment)

- Thorough knowledge of the proper installation, operation and maintenance of the various components of the municipal electric distribution and transmission system
- Thorough knowledge of operation and maintenance of light and heavy electric construction equipment
- Thorough knowledge of proper safety practices applicable to the electric industry
- Thorough knowledge of transformer, capacitor and substation connections
- Knowledge of departmental policy and procedure
- Knowledge of employee handbook and union contract

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- Skill in the use of voltage and amperage meters, hand and power tools
- Ability to recognize unusual or threatening conditions and take corrective action or report to the Lineworker Supervisor for assistance in corrective action
- Ability to carry out detailed oral or written instruction
- Ability to read engineering drawings
