
SCHEDULE EDR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RATE

APPLICABILITY

(Adopted by Resolution No. 7, 2011)

Applicable to qualified commercial/industrial customers receiving electric service from Bryan Municipal Utilities (BMU) under the Large Power Rate for the purpose of incenting businesses for attraction and/or expansion; as provided below. The Schedule is not available to business facilities involved in selling or providing goods and services directly to the general public.

BMU shall be responsible for establishing/enforcing rules and procedures for administering this rate schedule and determining whether customers meet the qualifications set forth herein. Customers shall provide information on a timely basis for the purposes of verifying eligibility and administering the terms of this rate schedule.

Customers desiring to take advantage of Schedule EDR must file an application with BMU for approval prior to initiation of the rate to the qualified new or expanded load. Customer shall provide BMU with information concerning the additional load to be served and the basis that the load will meet the minimum eligibility requirements of the EDR schedule.

This Schedule is available only to new loads where the demand of the new load must equal or exceed 200 kW at 55% load factor or 79,200 kWh per month during at least three months of a twelve-month period. Eligibility for this rider under the preceding minimum load requirement is subject to review on an annual basis

All terms and conditions of the Large Power Rate schedule shall apply to service supplied to the Customer except as modified by this Schedule.

This Schedule is not available to a new customer which results from a change in ownership of existing establishment. However, if a change in ownership occurs after the customer contracts for service under this Schedule, the successor customer may be allowed to fulfill the balance of the contract under the EDR Schedule and continue the credits outlined below. This Schedule is also not available for renewal of service following interruptions such as equipment failure, temporary plant shutdown, strike, or economic conditions. This Schedule is also not available for load shifted from one establishment or delivery on the BMU system to another on the BMU system.

CONTRACT PERIOD

Prior to receiving service under this Schedule, the Customer must enter into a contract to purchase all of the electric energy requirements used by Consumer at its facility from BMU for a minimum period of 5 years. Either party can terminate the contract at the end of the original term upon sixty days prior written notice

MONTHLY CREDIT

As an incentive for adding new load at its facility located in the City of Bryan, BMU agrees to provide Consumer a \$0.01 per kWh discount for the monthly energy usage in excess of Consumer's Base Monthly Usage of as determined by the Director of Utilities based on a review of Consumer's historical energy usage. Said discount shall be applied during the thirty six (36) consecutive monthly billing periods following the Effective Date.
