## Economic Development Rate

**Bryan Municipal Utilities Schedule EDR offers incentives for retention, expansion and/or attraction of Large Power commercial and industrial electric customers**



### Schedule EDR

Bryan Municipal Utilities (BMU) has a vested interest in the economic vitality and growth of our community. Economic development can benefit Bryan not only through job retention and creation, but by reducing the average cost of utility service to all customers.

Electric service reliability and costs are critical elements of success for many firms and an important consideration in business retention, expansion and attraction decisions.

BMU offers Schedule EDR to qualified businesses that locate or expand operations in Bryan. Schedule EDR participants may receive an electric rebate or billing credit of \$0.026 per kWh on new or increased electric consumption for up to three years.

### Schedule EDR Eligibility

Schedule EDR is available to qualified BMU Large Power electric customers. New or additional customer loads must be equal to or less than 1 MW with an annual load factor equal to or greater than 55%.

Utility representatives work with interested customers to establish a 12-month historic Base Annual Energy Use. BMU continues to bill participating customers at the Large Power rate for the next 12 months. At the end of this 12-month period, actual energy use is compared to the customer's Base Annual Energy Use. If actual energy consumption exceeds Base Annual Energy Use, BMU issues a rebate or billing credit to the customer for the increased kWhs multiplied by \$0.026 per kWh.

Schedule EDR is a performance based incentive—participating customers must grow and sustain increased electric load to qualify for rebates/billing credits in each of three successive 12-month periods after commencement of service under Schedule EDR. There is no penalty for failure to increase or sustain energy use greater than the energy use baseline period.

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# **Schedule EDR** *Economic Development Rate*

## **Availability**

Schedule EDR is available to qualified commercial/industrial customers receiving electric service under Bryan Municipal Utilities' (BMU) Large Power Rate Schedule as provided below:

BMU shall establish policies and procedures for administering Schedule EDR and determine whether customers meet the qualifications set forth herein. Customers shall provide information on a timely basis for purposes of verifying eligibility and administering Schedule EDR.

Customers desiring to take advantage of Schedule EDR must submit a completed application for BMU's review and approval prior to commencement of service. Customers shall provide BMU with information concerning their projected new or increased electric load and the basis for determining that the projected new or increased electric load will meet Schedule EDR eligibility requirements.

Schedule EDR is available to new or increased electric loads of 1.0 MW or less where the customer's annual load factor equals or exceeds 55% each 12-month period during the three-year term of service. Eligibility under the preceding minimum load factor requirement is subject to review on an annual basis. Schedule EDR assumes no BMU capital investment is required to serve the additional load.

All terms and conditions of the Large Power Rate Schedule (including Power Supply Cost Adjustment and kilowatt-hour tax) apply to service provided to participating customers except as modified by Schedule EDR.

Schedule EDR is not available to new customers resulting from change of ownership of an existing firm or facility. However, if a change of ownership occurs after a customer contracts for service under Schedule EDR, the successor customer may be allowed to fulfill the remaining term of service under Schedule EDR and receive billing credits or rebates as outlined below during such remaining term.

Schedule EDR is not available for renewal of service following interruptions such as equipment failure, temporary plant shutdown, strike or economic conditions. Schedule EDR is also not available for load shifted from one facility or delivery point on the BMU electric transmission and distribution system to another location on the BMU system.

## **Term of Service**

Participating Schedule EDR customers are eligible to receive billing credits or rebates for up to three successive 12-month periods after commencement of service under Schedule EDR.

## **Annual Billing Credit or Rebate**

As an incentive for increasing or adding new load at a facility located in the City of Bryan, BMU offers participating customers a \$0.026 per kWh billing credit or rebate for Actual Annual Energy Use that exceeds the customer's Base Annual Energy Use. For existing customers, Base Annual Energy Use is based on customer's historic energy use. The billing credit or rebate, if applicable, is issued after each successive 12-month period following the Effective Date during a three-year term of service under Schedule EDR.

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
